students an all-inclusive educational experience focusing on vocational, employable, and independent living skills!

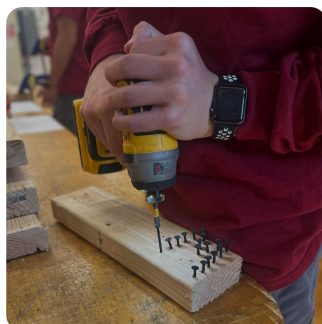
AROUND THE CTC

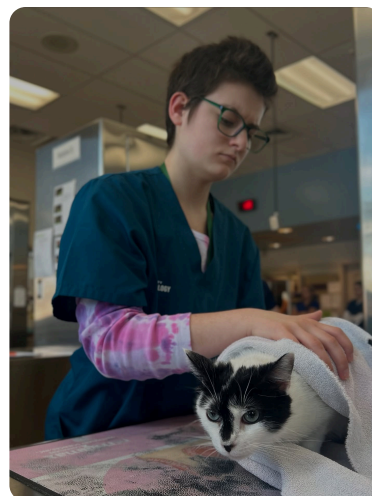


September 9, 2025
