Dear Student and Parent/Guardian:

We would like to welcome you to the Interactive Media & Web Design program at the Lancaster County Career and Technology Center, Brownstown Campus. Students will explore website development, graphic art programs, and desktop publishing. You will learn HTML, CCS, JavaScript fundamentals, Web Design principles, animation and web building software, basic scripting and programming, audio and video production, and portfolio preparation.

Upon completion of the program, you will have an excellent technical background that will assist you in continuing your education at the post-secondary level. This program will also help you obtain the skills needed to find an entry-level position with an organization that uses the Internet for marketing, advertising, or promotion.

The uniform for Interactive Media & Web Design is one or all of the following Indigo Blue CTC t-shirts, long sleeved CTC t-shirts, hooded CTC sweatshirts with black pants (not jeans, not Dickies), and closed-toe shoes (not boots, and certainly not sandals). Students are required to purchase the uniform over the summer. Uniform shirts are available online at www.lancasterctc.edu. Pants and shoes may be purchased at the store of your choice.

Students will be required to complete an online OSHA 10-hour General Safety certification. The school will pay for this certification. Please note that additional certifications may be available to the program and the student, and may have a cost associated with them.

Students are highly encouraged to participate in the student organization SkillsUSA. "SkillsUSA empowers its members to become world-class leaders, craftspersons, and responsible American citizens. SkillsUSA improves the quality of our nation's future skilled workforce through the development of framework skills that include personal, workplace, and technical skills grounded in academics."
