As we all are looking forward to the start of the 2025-2026 school year, please let me welcome you to the Introduction to Construction Careers program at the Brownstown campus of Lancaster CTC. My name is Corey Andrew and I am your instructor for the program. I have over 30 years experience in construction and I look forward to helping you develop skills in carpentry, plumbing, electrical, painting, flooring, HVAC, and concrete. As well as, building related skills like reading blueprints, reading a tape measure, working with hand tools, and power tools. Students will learn various tasks relating to aspects of each of these trades as we build a real duplex project house in our workshop.

Skills will be covered to increase student success in the classroom as well as the workplace like basic construction math, using a calculator, note-taking skills, reading for comprehension, study skills, workplace responsibility, maintaining a positive attitude, and demonstrating good work ethic. Report card grades will reflect evaluation in three areas: theory (class work and quizzes), work ethic (dependability, punctuality, cooperation, attitude, etc.), and skills performance/productivity (workmanship).

To maintain a safe and productive environment, a dress code and lab safety rules are enforced. Horseplay, swearing, misuse of hand or power tools, or any other shop equipment will not be tolerated. Together we will create a safe learning environment for all.

LCCTC requires a uniform. Introduction to Construction Career students are required to wear *navy-blue* Dickies or similar brand work pants, *sport-gray* LCCTC t-shirts, long sleeve t-shirts, and crew sweatshirts. Students must order uniform shirts from Fully Promoted through the LCCTC website school store (www.lancasterctc.edu). Please place an order promptly to ensure your student will be in uniform on their first day of school. Pants need to be purchased separately. Fully Promoted does not sell pants. Over the summer, students will need to purchase enough work pants to make it through a five day work week. Work pants are available at Walmart, Tractor Supply, Gabe's, T.J. Maxx, and area hardware stores. Jeans, shorts, joggers and capris are not permitted. We suggest that students purchase at least three pairs of pants, four shirts, and one sweatshirt. Students will also need leather work boots, steel-toed is optional.

I am looking forward to a great school year! I hope you all are looking forward to learning and developing your skills and abilities which leads you to real opportunities. Have a great summer and I can't wait to meet you all!
