


### UX/UI Web Design – Music Fest Website

If they manage their time wisely, in most cases they will not have homework.


#### **TAKING LAPTOP HOME:**

#### **INTERNET USE:**

The internet is to be used for learning and projects only. Internet usage and traffic is monitored and no **UNAPPROVED** access is permitted (ex: YouTube, Music Sites, Gaming Sites)!



#### **FOOD & DRINKS:**

No food or drink is permitted in the classroom or near workstations, without prior approval! The only exception is a personal water bottle the must have a sealable lid, NO EXCEPTIONS.

ABSOLUTELY NO OPEN CONTAINERS or CANS for any reason!





#### **SCHOOL UNIFORM:**

All students are required to wear their school uniform at CTC. Uniform are Indigo blue CTC t-shirt, black pants and closed-toe shoes.







#### **PERSONAL HYGIENE:**
