Uniform Requirements for Painting & Interior Finishes Students

Welcome! I'm excited to meet each of you and spend the year teaching valuable skills that will prepare you for success in the painting industry and beyond.

As part of our program, a **uniform is required starting on the first day of school**. Below are the approved uniform options for students to order from Fully Promoted:

- CHARCOAL Short Sleeve Tee
- CHARCOAL Long Sleeve Tee
- CHARCOAL Crew Neck Sweatshirt
- CHARCOAL Hooded Sweatshirt
- White or Tan Painters' Work Pants (Can be purchased at Sherwin Williams)
- BLACK Polos (optional but recommended for job interviews or special occasion events)

CTC logo hats are available as a new addition and are permitted in class, **or industry partner hats.**

Work boots are required to be worn every day. Since we spend long periods on our feet, I highly recommend investing in a comfortable and supportive pair of work boots. Additionally, there will be times when we work in cold environments, so it's important to have long sleeve shirts, crew neck sweatshirts, or hooded sweatshirts available to stay warm.

Because paint and other materials can stain clothing, I strongly suggest purchasing multiple sets of the uniform. Having extras will ensure you always have a clean set available. Uniforms must be washed on a weekly basis, which is why having more than one is helpful.

I look forward to working with all of you and helping you develop skills that will serve you well in the future!
