Uniforms are required on the first day of school. Uniform information is enclosed with this letter. Please order your uniforms promptly. In addition to purchasing your uniform at Pro-Look, they may be purchased in store and online at other retailers if colors are exact (Cherokee brand colors – pewter (grey), black and electric pink). In regard to outside opportunities and job shadowing, **you are expected to provide your own transportation to and from those sites.** 

Our grading systems are different than the traditional method of grading. 33% of the grade is knowledge. This includes exams, homework, class assignments, projects, and completion of certifications. 33% of the grade is skills. This is the actual completion of hands-on skills in the lab. There are task sheets provided for every skill to list the step-by-step process of what is expected. The last 33% of the grade is work ethic. The goal is to prepare you for a career in the workforce. There are skills that make you employable. This includes showing up on time, wearing the correct uniform and following all uniform rules (shoes, jewelry, hair, and nails), participation, having a positive attitude, and being respectful.

If you are going to drive to school instead of riding the bus, you must be present at 8 am and stay until 2:35 pm, regardless of when your school bus would arrive or leave. Failure to follow these rules could result in disciplinary action, loss of driving privileges, and loss of any outside opportunities.

We have given you a lot of information, but we hope it has helped in answering many of your questions. A <u>student handbook</u> will be reviewed at the <u>beginning</u> of school in order to make you aware of all school policies.
