WHAT WILL YOU LEARN IN THIS CLASS?

- Anatomy & Physiology- the structure and function of the body in normal states. The body when it's diseased.
- Medical Terminology- will look at each body system and learn common medical terminology specific to that body system. You will also learn common medical abbreviations used in health care.
 - Earn credits from HACC if participating in dual-enrollment
- Nursing Assistant Skills
 - Taking BP/Pulse/Respiration/Temperature
 - Making beds, transferring patients to chairs, wheelchairs, and bedside commodes, removing IV's & foley catheters
 - Personal care of a patient- bathing, feeding, and dressing
 - EKG's & bladder scans

REQUIREMENTS FOR CLASS/CLINICAL INTERNSHIP

- Grades/Attendance

CLINICAL INTERNSHIP

- It is a privilege
- Grade Requirements
 - 90% average in daily score
 - 85% average in theory (A&P & Med Term)
 - 85% average in skill testing
 - Must practice when time is given, failure to practice will result in loss of internship
- Competent or Advanced on NOCTI at the end of the year
- Less than 5 days absent
 - Included in this total are tardies to school. Once you reach 5 tardies, you will earn 1 absence.



CLINICAL INTERNSHIP CONTINUED...

- Must provide own transportation
 - 6:30-2:00
- LGH & WellSpan Ephrata are clinical sites
 - Mandatory drug screening prior to start of clinical
- Instructor discretion as to hospital placement
 - Students may rotate through both facilities

 - Pictures will be taken during first week of school






- Online orders can be shipped to your home, and that option can be selected in the online store
