- Assists the patients (treatments and husbandry)
- Assists the client (building relationships)
- Assists with cleaning, stocking, and office responsibilities



- Surgery clinic patients are from local rescues/shelters
- We focus on small animal medicine (dogs & cats) mainly, as this is what you will find in general practice

## ITEMS TO REMEMBER

- NO facial piercings of any kind, including gauges, nose, and tongue piercings
- Only 2 piercings per ear with small stud-type earrings
