I would like to welcome you to the Architectural CAD/Design program at the Lancaster County Career and Technology Center, Brownstown Campus. The Drafting profession is several thousand years old and has become a worldwide method of communicating engineering ideas. The need for skilled drafting technicians is tremendous and should continue to improve through the next couple of decades. This program will also give you an excellent technical background to continue your education at the post-secondary level.

Draftspersons work in a professional office and are required to dress appropriately. Students need to comply with the LCCTC uniform requirement. Architectural CAD/Design students are required to purchase tan/khaki colored twill pants and navy blue LCCTC polo shirts (short-sleeved t-shirts are not acceptable), and crew sweatshirts. Students must order uniform shirts from Fully Promoted through the LCCTC website school store (www.lancasterctc.edu). Please place an order promptly to ensure your students will be in uniform on their first day of school. Students must purchase pants on their own over the summer. Jeans, shorts, and capris are not permitted. Pants must be properly sized. No baggy pants are allowed due to the safety factor when working with equipment, tools, and machines. We strongly suggest that students purchase at least two pairs of pants and five shirts, including one sweatshirt. Shoes may not be open toed; sneakers, boots, casual dress shoes.

Students will be required to take the following certification. This item will be acquired and paid for by the school.

International Residential Code certification

Please note that additional certifications may become available to the program and the student. Additional certifications may have a cost associated with them. However, these certifications would not be a requirement for the class.

Students are encouraged to participate in the student organization SkillsUSA. "SkillsUSA empowers its members to become world-class workers, leaders, and responsible American citizens. SkillsUSA improves the quality of our nation's future skilled workforce through the development of Framework skills that include personal, workplace, and technical skills grounded in academics." If students choose to participate, there may be a membership fee to join.
