The Computer Networking & Security Program at the Brownstown Campus of the Lancaster County Career & Technology Center prepares students for an entry-level career in the field of Information Technology. Students in the program should be prepared for the following:

1. Design, install, and troubleshoot computer networking servers and network services.
2. Instruction in operating systems and applications; systems design and analysis.

This course requires a few purchases to be made by you, the student. All purchased material belongs solely to you and is your property to be taken with you when you finish the course. Texts, tools, and other learning documents are chosen and designed to be used when you are employed in the industry or continue to higher education. I have created lists of tools, books, and other items that students are encouraged to compile to use as they start their careers.

Please note that additional certifications may incur additional costs and this will be discussed during the year.

Students are encouraged to participate in the student organization SkillsUSA. "SkillsUSA empowers its members to become world-class workers, leaders, and responsible American citizens. SkillsUSA improves the quality of our nation's future skilled workforce through the development of Framework skills that include personal, workplace, and technical skills grounded in academics." If students choose to participate, there will be a membership fee to join.

The uniform for the Computer Networking & Security program is a forest green CTC shirt, sweatshirt, khaki pants (not jeans, not Dickies), and closed-toe shoes (not boots, and certainly not sandals). Students are required to purchase uniforms over the summer. Uniform shirts are available online at www.lancasterctc.edu. Pants and shoes may be purchased at the store of your choice. The cost for these items will be around **\$70.00** and up.

The Lancaster County Career & Technology Center is a training facility for individuals who have a strong sense of what they want their future to be. As such, professionalism is a part of the curriculum. Students are expected to take an active role in their training.
