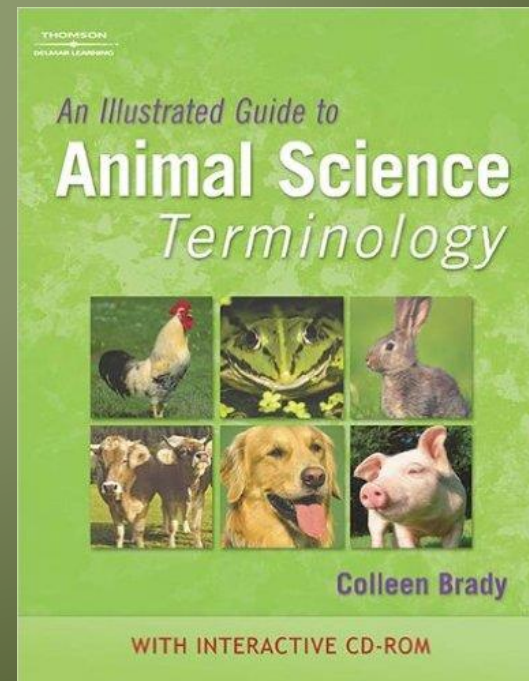
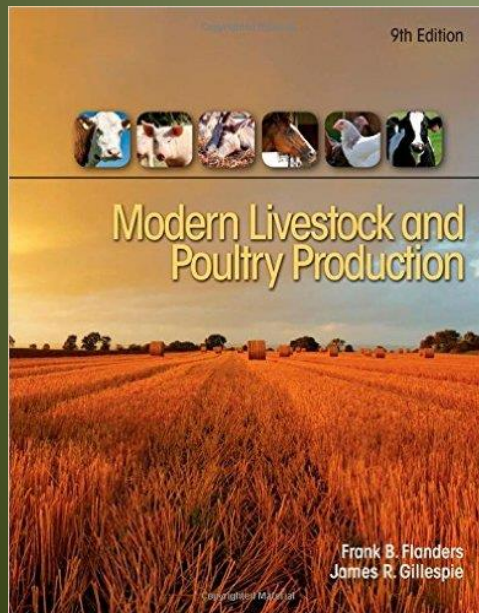

Co-op/API

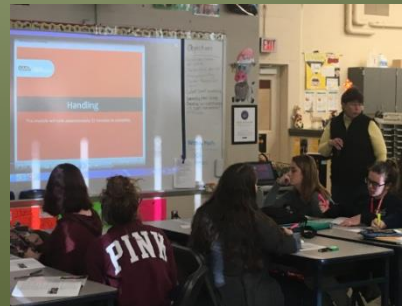
- Co-op = Paid Position

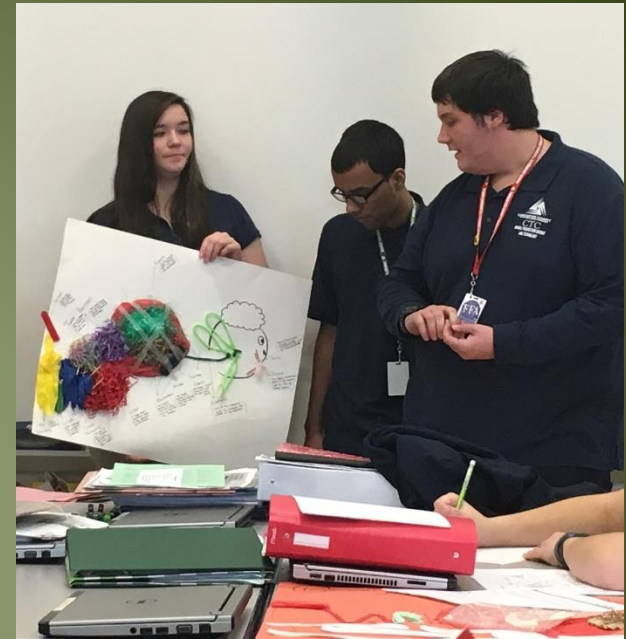

 - Check with the Lancaster County Career & Technology Foundation



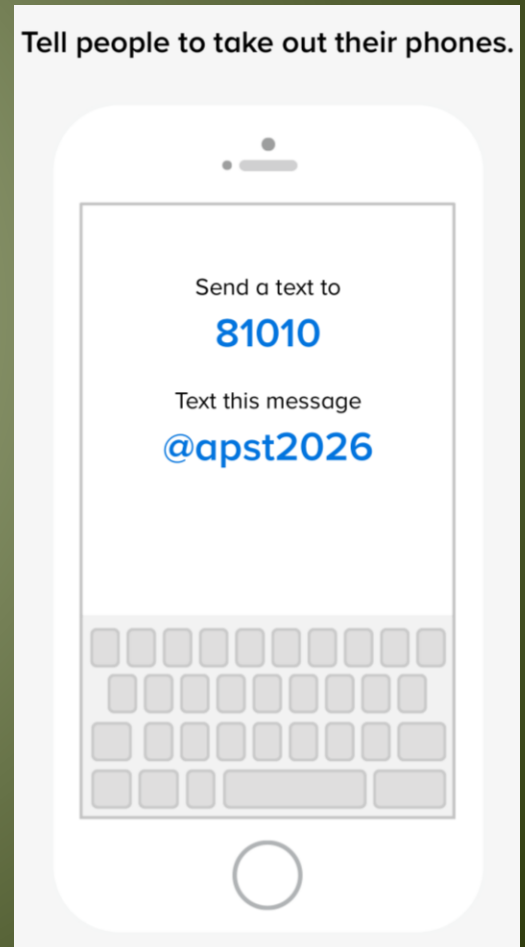
Cell Phones & Technology

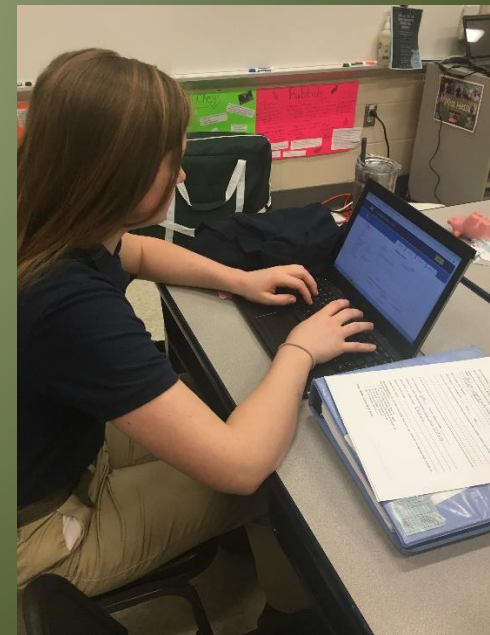
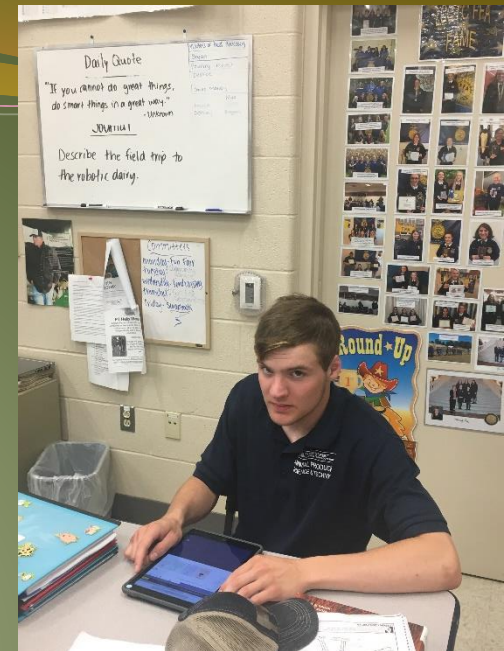
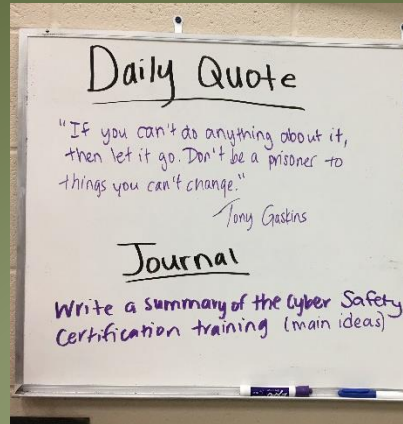

Journals

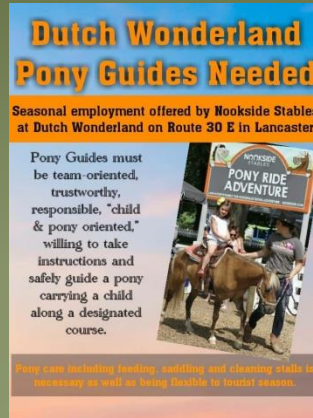
• Journal Board

- Daily Agenda

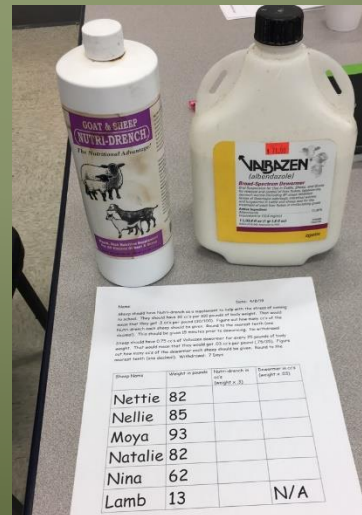
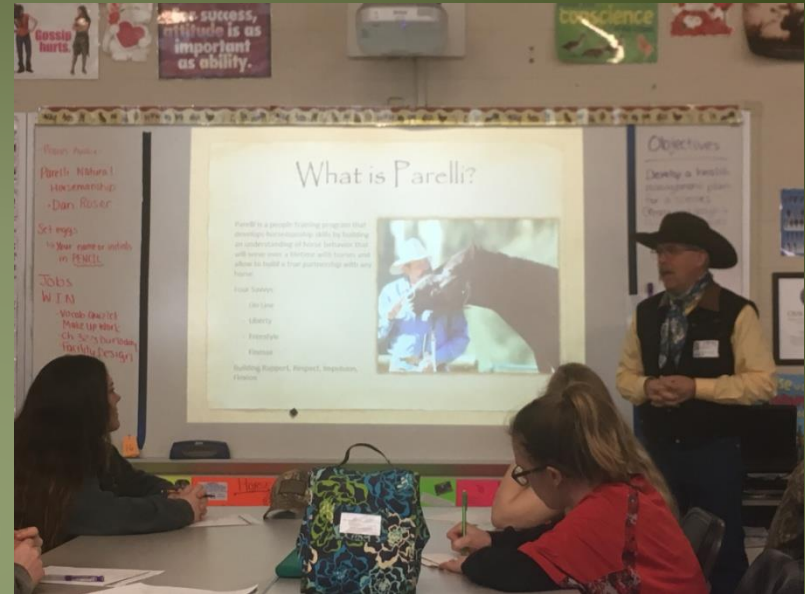
- Morning Schedule
